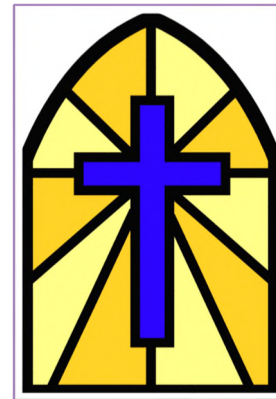
List of First Aiders
