## Prayer

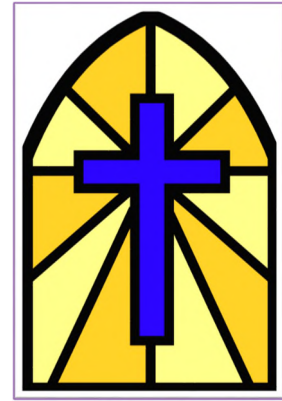
