## Don't...Save The Date

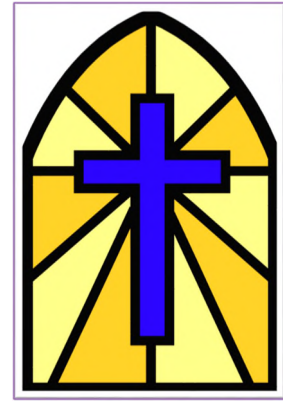
On Saturday August 1<sup>st</sup>, we were hoping to host a fundraising supper in aid of the earthquake victims in Nepal.
