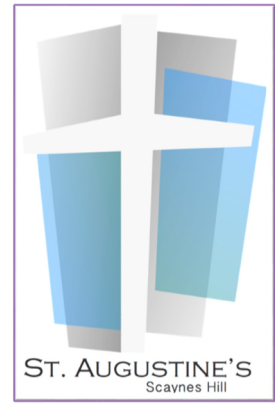
Our annual memorial service, to remember and give thanks for loved ones who've died, will take place on Sunday 1st November, at 3pm. All are welcome.
