This week we are looking at some Bible verses relating to healing, and we first look at the statement that our Lord Jesus made. I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full ... John 10:10.

SUNDAY

You do not have, because you do not ask God ... James 4:2. Forgive us Lord that we sometimes make you the last resort instead of the first. Holy Spirit, we ask that you would remind us to take all our burdens to you in prayer.

MONDAY

Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray ... James 5:13. Sometimes Father we can get so weary with our troubles especially health issues that it is an effort to pray, please help us in our weakness to come to you, where we find strength and hope.

We pray for the Diocesan Overseas Council meeting today and tomorrow. We also pray this week for the Wilson family and, in particular, for Ronan Wilson who has suffered a nasty break to his elbow which will require surgery. We pray for Mark as he goes through this week and that he receives your peace and strength.

TUESDAY

Is any one of you sick? He should call for the elders of the church to pray over him ... the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well. James 5:14-15. Father, you don't heal everyone in this life and we don't always understand why, but help us to play our part in faithful prayer.

WEDNESDAY

Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective. James 5:16. Heavenly Father, may we have good friendships and short accounts with you, that our prayers would not be hindered.

We pray for Thomas Martin as he has his operation, and for the family today.

THURSDAY

He heals the broken hearted and binds up their wounds. Psalm 147:3. For those who have received bad news, struggling with family problems, bereavement, work related problems or bullying, please heal and bind their wounds. We pray for the school meeting and interviews today.

FRIDAY

But you are a forgiving God, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love. Nehemiah 9:17. We pray for Gwyneth Paine, for healing and for wisdom for the doctors as they do tests, because you love her.

We pray for Revd and Mrs Foko returning to Cameroon today.

SATURDAY

Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen. Ephesians 3:20.

We pray for today's parish away day and for Julie as she leads, that you would work within us, and we would give you great pleasure and glory.
