Dear Saviour, quicken my lethargic spirit, show me where I need to grow and when I grieve your heart. Mend me as you mend me, that we may be one, and love me into your likeness - before you bring me home. We pray for Mark at the General Synod in York, meeting today and tomorrow.

SATURDAY

Lord, nudge us into your will and away from our wants. Reduce us to size. Show us your mighty arm! Carry our sin away and move us into action that we may be a walking statement of your message of love to our world.

SUNDAY

O God you are the Healer, promising bruised reeds that you shall not break, we pray for all people in this place ... touch them Lord - bring your healing hand low to their pain. Do your work, show us your heart, hear us, help us, heal us. We pray for hearts ready to worship today and for Jeremy Taylor as he speaks at Kairos tonight.
