This weeks prayers are taken from the prayers of King Solomon in 1 Kings 8.

MONDAY

O Lord, there is no God like you in heaven above or on earth below - you who keep your covenant of love with your servants who continue wholeheartedly in your way.

TUESDAY

Now Lord God, keep for us the promises that you have made to us in your Word, and let your Word come true, let it come to life, and may it come to bear much fruit.

WEDNESDAY

God in Heaven, give attention to your servant's prayer, and our plea for mercy. O Lord our God, hear the cry and the prayer that your servant is praying in your presence this day, hear from heaven and when you hear, forgive.

THURSDAY

When a prayer is prayed by your children - each one aware of the afflictions of their own heart, then hear from heaven and forgive and act, since you alone know the hearts of all men.

FRIDAY

When we sin against you - for there is no-one who does not sin, and if we repent, then hear from heaven our prayer and plea and forgive your people and the offences we have committed against you.

SATURDAY

May the Lord our God be with us; may he never leave us or forsake us, may he turn our hearts to him, to walk in all his ways being fully committed to him, and to keep his commands.

SUNDAY

May these words of ours be near to the Lord our God, day and night, that he may uphold the cause of his people according to each days needs, so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the Lord is God and that there is no other.
