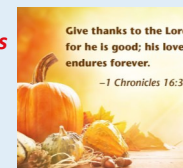

that we might yield goodness, patience and kindness in abundance.*

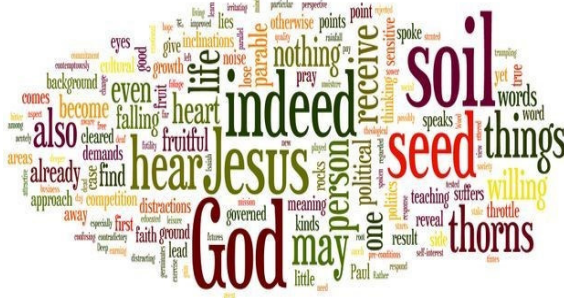
*Sow a seed of peace in our lives Lord,
