- There is wheelchair access from the street through the Annexe main door.
- We have two toilets (one disabled) in the Annexe.
- A loop system is available for the hard of hearing.
- During all 10.00 am services there is a crèche and toys, activities and highchairs are available in the Annexe.
- There is Sunday Club for older children during the 10.00 am service in term time.
