## Our Mission in This Month is ..... Off the Fence



In 1983, Paul Young and his wife Wendy responded to the question "when are Christians going to get off the fence and do something about social poverty?"

They went out into the streets of Brighton and Hove to help the most marginalized and vulnerable, speaking with the homeless, guiding them to services in the city where they could receive help. Soon a friend joined them and then three more. They started by giving out sleeping bags, clothes and hot drinks and then they obtained a coach in which they could accommodate six homeless people over the winter months.

Eventually the team numbered seventy and in 1997 Off The Fence became a registered charity. Since then their activities have widened to operate in three main areas: homelessness, women at risk and schools and youth. They have two day centres, three outreach vans and work in 15 local schools with over 150 trained volunteers and staff. Off The Fence's mission is engage with those in need and those who want to support their work to eradicate social and spiritual poverty in Brighton & Hove and bring hope and transformation across the City.

- During all 10.00 am services there is a crèche and toys, activities and highchairs are available in the Annex.
- There is Sunday Club for older children during the 10.00 am service in term time.
- Everyone is very welcome to receive bread and wine regardless of denomination. If you would prefer not to receive communion, you are still very welcome to come forward for a blessing. Please keep your hands below the altar rail to show this is your intention.
- Gluten free wafers and non-alcoholic wine are available. If you would like either of these, please speak to one of the people who welcomed you today.
- Collections are made during most services but there are donation envelopes and a wall safe at the back of Church.
- Please feel free to take leaflets, handouts and other information at the back of Church and on the table in the Annex.
- There is a small lending library in the Annexe.
- There are refreshments on offer in the Annex after all 10.00 am Sunday services.
