In this goody-packed event, bestselling author & activist Isabel Losada will waste no time.



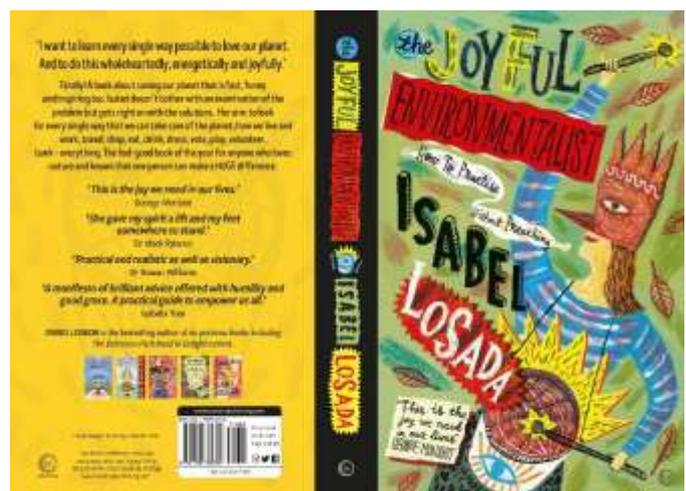
The way to feel depressed about the planet is to think of all the things that we can't influence.
